



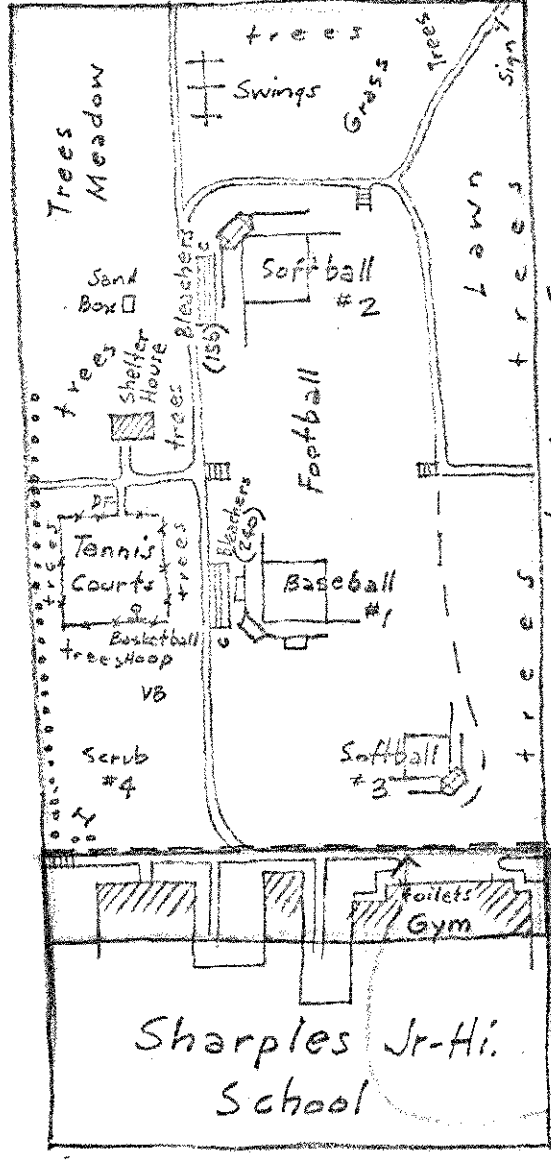

Presence of many stumps + filling of playfield  
area with garbage (until 1925) caused a long delay
