

McGilvra Blvd. named to honor Judge J. J. McGillvra who home site was on the lakeshore @ Madison St., known then as "Laurel Sh. 42" now part of Madison Park.

(John J. McGillvra, born in New York State 1827, moved to Illinois, teaching & preparing for bar. During Chicago practice he associated w/ A. Lincoln, who later appointed McGillvra as US Attorney for Wash. Terr. Entered private practice in Seattle, elected to Terr. Legist., promoted Squamish Pass road & railroad to Seattle, as City Attorney prosecuted Seattle's claim to 320 acres under townsite law, advocated Ship Canal, supported Cedar Mtn. water project; invested heavily in Real Estate. Died 1903.)
