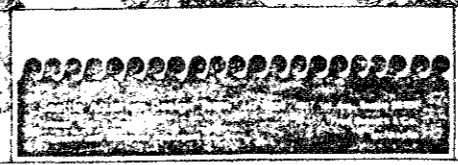

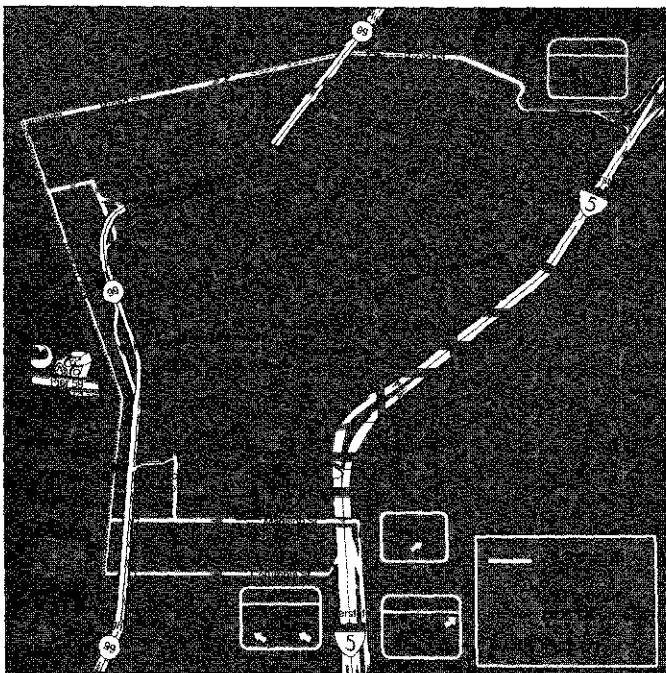
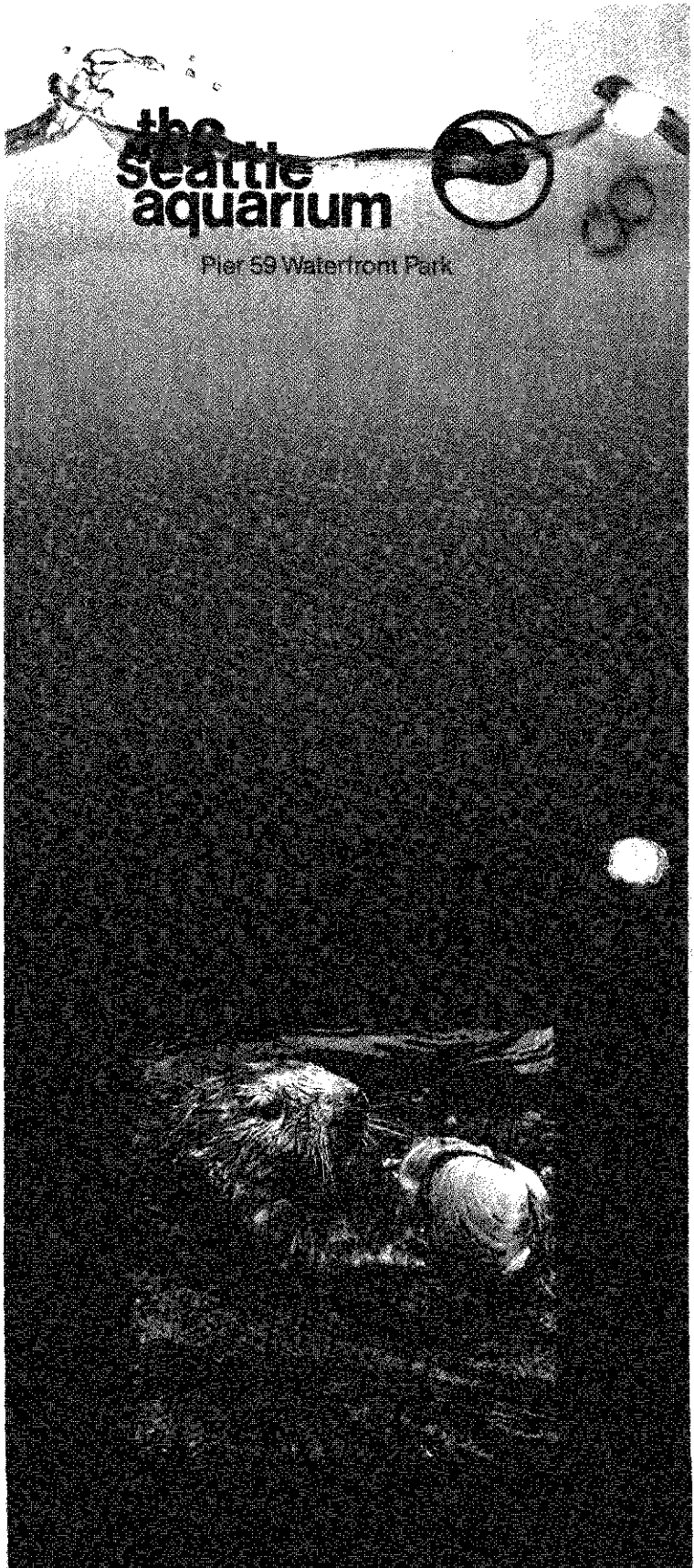
Attire: Some Aquarium exhibits are outdoors, so wear appropriate clothing.

Time: Allow at least an hour to view all of the exhibits.

Access: WALK from the Pike Place Market. Take the Waterfront BUS #25 Lakeview from points on the waterfront or downtown (see map). PUBLIC PARKING on the street or under the viaduct.

Annual Passes: Yearly individual and family passes are available at the Aquarium. Individual (\$15); Family (\$25); Teen (13-18) and Senior (\$10).

Special Programs: Several exhibit tours each day; classes and exhibit visits for grades K through 12; college program; evening film/lecture series; summer lectures and exhibit visits; educator workshops. For details phone 625-5030.
