honors Wash. city which was named from Indian tribe = "children of sun". First established residence of white men in (State of Wash.) was at Spokane House in 1810, a fur trading post

Total - 137.4 Acres [Purch. by City from State 1897]
Transf. 1909 for park + parkway purposes.
NW portion transf. to Water Dept. 1935 for reservoir (150,000)
Unused portion developed as playground by permit: 1947 (11 Ac.)

Playfield name taken from Golf Course which was named to honor the 3rd President.

Short 9 (originally opened 1922) closed in 1941 with installation of anti-aircraft guns; playfield - site of Recreation Camp: large shop building was camp skating rink. Short 9, Driving Range, P.F. reshuffled w/ construction of school and of Veterans' hospital (site given for hospital)
Playfield developed in Agreement with School Board - 1955 - for joint-use of field + school facilities.

BOWLING GREEN: Drinking Ftn. in honor of Beryl Wells, Lawn Bowler; Park Board member 1938-44, Funeral Director (Columbia) and Civic leader.
Original Bowling Green const. just south of Golf Clubhouse in 1944. Const. of a Driving Range, rebuilding of Short 9 in 1948 necessitated relocation of Bowling Greens to present location. (As noted above, Driving Range moved + Short 9 redesigned - 1955.)
Bowling Green operated since 1945 by Agreement with Jeff. Pk. Lawn Bowlg. Club.
