

Plan Set for Occidental Roller Rink

Survey of Current Conditions

The Downtown Seattle Association (DSA) is currently under contract with Seattle Parks and Recreation to manage and activate Occidental Square Park. In accordance with that agreement one of the ways DSA is tasked with is managing and activating the space for public use and enjoyment. Current conditions are light and underused. As part of All Star Game Week programming DSA is proposing to bring a beer garden for free public use for a limited duration of time (Installation on July 8th with removal on July 11th).

Proposed Installation Dimensions

Footprint for proposed beer garden installation includes a 20 ft x 40 ft fenced off bar with tables and chairs.

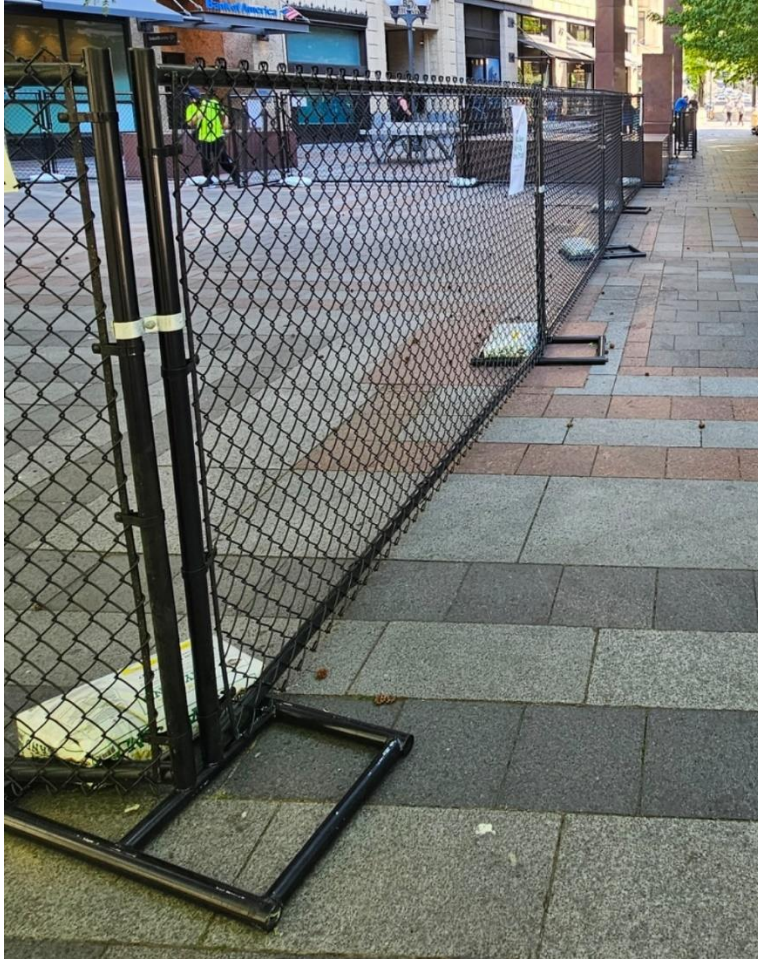

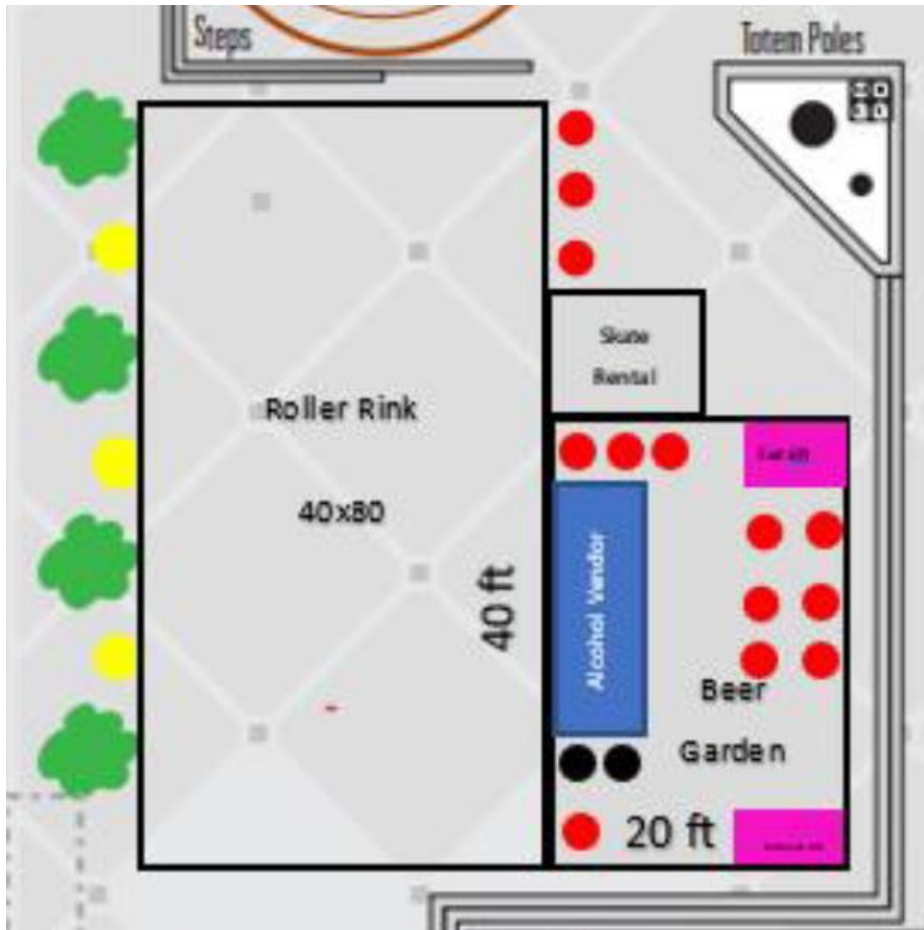
Fencing

We have dark green chain link fence that we will be installing for the duration of the event. Fencing is held in place by a base that is weighed down by sandbags. No drilling or harming of the pavers at Occidental will occur.



Beer Garden Location at Occidental

The below photo is where the beer garden will be placed. The only park items that will be moved are movable tables and chairs. We will move the chairs and tables on Saturday July 8th to other areas of the park and then move them back on Tuesday, July 11th once the rink is removed. We may use some of our tables and chairs depending on what the vendor agrees to bring



Additional Details

There are no attachments to the ground. The beer garden shouldn't have any impact on the park.

Beer garden will operate from 11 a.m. to 6 p.m. daily.

There will be some Anheuser-Busch signage as well as some DSA signs. Will allow bar vendor to have some visible signs.

Public bathrooms will be in the park for days that beer garden is open.
