

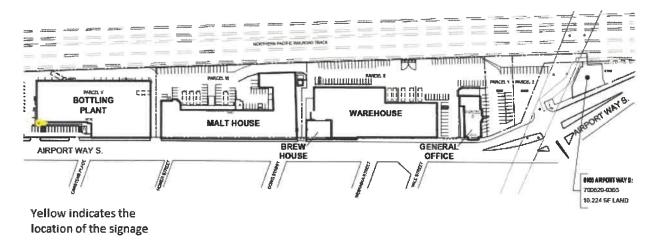

Original Rainier Brewery Tenant Signage

Dear Erin Doherty,

We have a new tenant at the Bottling Plant named RHI, address 5826 Airport Way S. The tenant is located at the north end of the building, with a separate entrance from the rest of the building.



Below is a picture of tenant RHI's individual entrance to the Bottling Plant. RHI plans to mount their signage above the door between the band of bricks and over the door. Current bolts shown in the "before" picture will be removed. The new sign will be mounted on fasteners that are within the mortar joints to avoid damaging any of the historic brick.





Here is a larger picture of the Bottling Plant Building. Note that handicapped parking signs are properly on poles, not on the building. The La Tavola sign will be addressed in our next signage approval application addressing the retail spaces in the lower floor of the building.



Here is a picture of the entrance with the RHI sign proposed. The sign itself will be 44" by 24" and the RHI lettering will be about 10" tall.



From the sign company:

I went with a flat sign, brushed silver finish and digital overlay. The sign would be spaced off the building about 1" and mounted on bolts that are anchored into the grout.
