INCIDENT SYNOPSIS

Officers were conducting a search warrant at a residence.

COMPLAINT

The complainant alleged that an Unknown Employee mishandled the wallet of a subject during a search warrant.

INVESTIGATION

The OPA investigation included the following actions:

1. Review of the complaint
2. Search for and review of all relevant records and other evidence
3. Review of In-Car Video (ICV)
4. Interview of SPD employees

ANALYSIS AND CONCLUSION

The OPA investigation carefully reviewed all of the documentation and available administrative records for this event. OPA was able to identify that the subject did have a wallet. However, the investigation was unable to determine where the wallet ended up or which employee was individually responsible for it.

FINDINGS

The evidence was not able determine whether or not the Unknown Employee mishandled evidence. Therefore a finding of **Not Sustained** (Inconclusive) was issued for *Detainee Property: Officers Secure Detainee Property*.
