## A NEIGHBORHOOD GREENWAY IS COMING TO YOUR NEIGHBORHOOD!

The following street improvements on NE 135th St will begin as soon as February 2024:

- Asphalt pathway connecting the street ends on NE 135th St between 27th Ave NE and 30th Ave NE
- Marked crosswalks on arterial streets of 30th Ave NE & NE 135th St
- Tree trimming and sidewalk smoothing
- Marked crosswalk with a flashing beacon on north side of 35th Ave NE & NE 135th St
- Stop signs with stop bars on side streets intersecting the Neighborhood Greenway
- Install signs and markings for wayfinding


We are excited to announce we are **starting construction on the Olympic Hills to Cedar Park Elementary Neighborhood Greenway on NE 135th St between 27th Ave NE & 37th Ave NE as soon as February 2024!** We'll be installing the Neighborhood Greenway in stages, starting this winter and finishing in 2024.

When construction is set to begin, "no parking" signs will be placed along this street in certain locations. **Please move your vehicles during the "no parking" timeframes, otherwise it will be towed.**

# Overview

This route has been identified as a Neighborhood Greenway. These streets will provide a safer, calmer route to the places people want to go in the neighborhood and connect to the growing network of Neighborhood Greenways, trails and protected bike lanes in Seattle. This Neighborhood Greenway has been planned in coordination with the Safe Routes to School Program and will provide a safer, more comfortable route for people walking and biking to Cedar Park Elementary.

## WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION:

Typical construction hours are weekdays, 7 AM to 5 PM, with occasional weekend and night work. Other expected construction effects may include:

- Temporary driveway impacts
- Noise and vibration
- Dust and debris
- Construction staging and parking impacts near the work sites
- Parking impacts
- Crosswalk and sidewalk closures, and detours for people walking and biking
- Roadway closures and detours for vehicle traffic
- Changes in construction schedule due to unforeseen circumstances (i.e., weather, soil conditions, etc.)

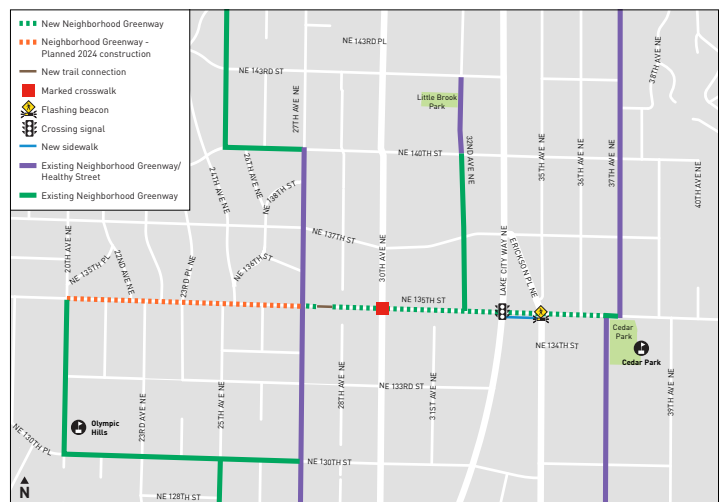

## WHAT IS A NEIGHBORHOOD GREENWAY?

Neighborhood greenways are safer, calmer residential streets for you, your family, and neighbors. We make people walking and biking the priority. The Cedar Park Elementary Neighborhood Greenway will include:

- Asphalt pathway connecting the street ends on NE 135th St between 27th Ave NE and 30th Ave NE
- New marked crosswalks on both arterial streets of 30th Ave NE & NE 135th St
- New marked crosswalk with a flashing beacon on the north side of 35th Ave NE & NE 135th St
- Stop signs with stop bars on side streets intersecting the Neighborhood Greenway
- Tree trimming and sidewalk smoothing
- Install signs and markings for wayfinding
