



Night work and I-5 ramp closures on Swift Ave S scheduled to begin Monday, April 1; southbound traffic detoured

Starting as early as Monday, April 1, crews will begin grinding the top several inches of asphalt on Swift Ave S between S Albro Pl and Beacon Ave S to prepare for paving (see map on next page).

You can anticipate:

- **Work hours from 7 PM – 7 AM Monday, April 1 through Thursday, April 4** as crews work to minimize daytime traffic disruptions.
- **Grinding to take about 4 days to complete**
Crews will focus work on one side of Swift Ave S to maintain one lane of northbound traffic, then flip to the other side.
- **Street repairs, April 3 to 11 (except Sunday)**
During the day, crews will be making additional repairs to the road, including casting repairs, concrete base repairs, and asphalt base repairs. This work will be noisy.
- **Paving work**
Scheduled to begin April 9, following grinding work. This work is weather dependent. Once paving is complete, temporary striping will be installed.

Actions for residents and businesses

- For your safety and the safety of our crews, keep away from the area while work is in progress, especially if you are with children or animals
- We realize the inconvenience this work creates and appreciate your patience. **Please contact the outreach team immediately if you have any accessibility needs or questions.**

I-5 ramps closed at 8 PM; southbound traffic closed between S Albro Pl and Beacon Ave S

- I-5 northbound ramp at Swift Ave S and S Graham St will be closed
- Exit 161 northbound to Swift Ave S and S Albro Pl will be closed
- Use S Columbian Way to get on / off I-5
- Southbound traffic on Swift Ave S will be detoured to S Columbian Way, northbound traffic will be maintained
- Limited turns to / from driveways where grinding is happening. Driveway access may be disrupted for 30 to 45 minutes as the grinding machine passes.
- Access to Swift Ave S from side streets will be closed. Please access residences from Beacon Ave S.
- Access to cars for people walking will be maintained when parked in driveways and on side streets; please use designated crossings for your safety.
