



CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

September 2018

Grinding and paving on 35th between NE 65th and NE 75th streets; no driveway access overnight September 28

Crews are preparing to pave 35th Ave NE between NE 65th and NE 75th streets.

- **September 18:** Crews plan to grind the northbound lane during the day
- **September 20:** Crews plan to grind the southbound lane during the day
- Lane closures will continue over several weeks while we make additional road repairs
- **September 28 and 29:** Crews expect to pave from 7 PM on Friday, September 28 to approx. 10 AM on Saturday, September 29, though work is weather dependent



WHAT TO EXPECT DURING GRINDING

- On-street parking closed on both sides of the street
- Crews will grind one side of the street at a time; please follow detour signs
- Driveway access may be disrupted for 30 to 60 minutes while the grinding machine is passing
- Limited turns to and from side streets
- Grinding work is noisy and dusty
- Typical work hours are 7 AM to 7 PM

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING PAVING

- **35th Ave NE will be closed to vehicles between NE 65th and NE 75th streets from 7 PM on Friday, September 28 until approx. 10 AM on Saturday, September 29.**
- **You will NOT be able to go in or out of driveways when the road is closed**
- Please park on side streets before 7 PM on Friday, September 28. Pedestrian access will be maintained to homes and businesses. We know this work is inconvenient, but it is necessary to protect the pavement and your vehicle.
- Fresh pavement is **hot, oily, and extremely sticky. Please keep off new pavement if you are walking, especially with dogs, as the oil and pavement can harm their feet.**
- This work is weather dependent and may be rescheduled to the night of October 5 if needed.
