

# 3rd Ave S and S Main St Bus Stop Improvements

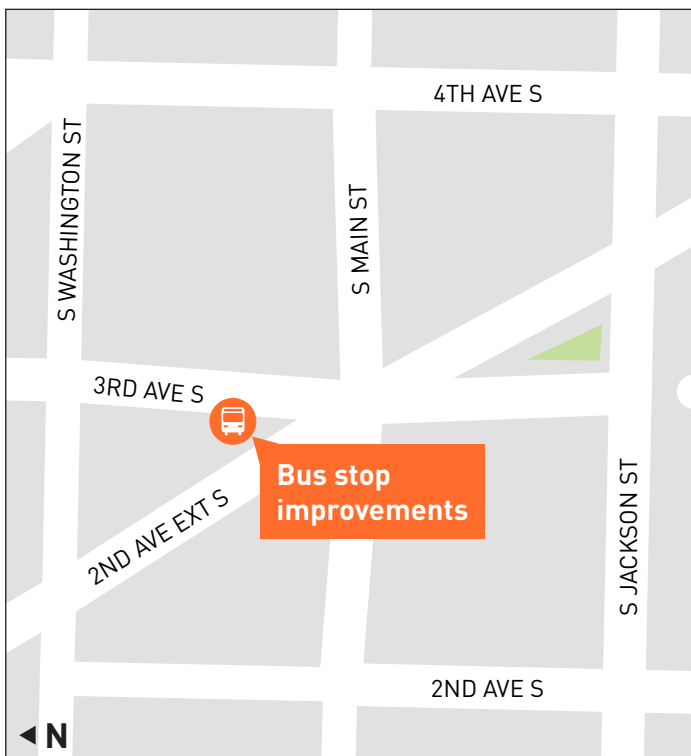
Creating a safer, more accessible, and more comfortable bus stop

## Project Overview

We're improving the bus stop on 3rd Ave S between S Washington St and S Main St to create a safer, more accessible, and more comfortable experience for people waiting for the bus. The project will help improve bus travel times and reliability by creating a better functioning bus stop and repairing and reconfiguring the street.

We're designing and building this project in partnership with King County Metro. This project is part of the Third Avenue Transit Corridor Improvements to improve transit connections and reliability on one of Seattle's most heavily-used transit corridors.

## Schedule

**Spring 2022:** Early project design

**Summer 2023:** Complete project design

**Early 2024:** Construction begins

**Summer 2024:** Construction complete

Project schedule subject to change.

## Project Design

Project improvements include:

- Widening sidewalks
- Repainting crosswalks
- Adding pedestrian lighting
- Planting new trees
- Adding other bus stop features including bus shelters, seating, real-time bus arrival information, and an ORCA card reader

We're making other improvements to the street between S Main St and S Washington St to help buses move more smoothly and efficiently. These improvements include:

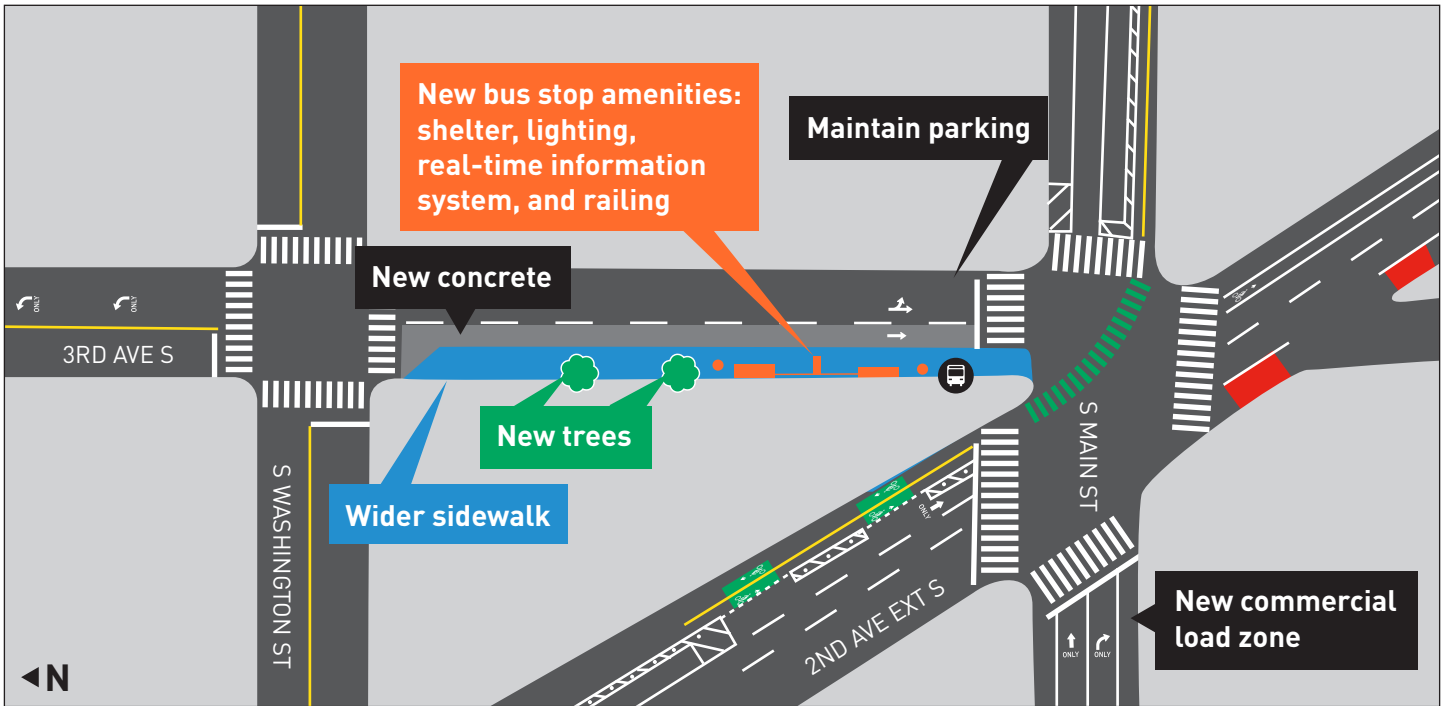
- Repairing the road next to the bus stop with new concrete paving
- Reconfiguring the street to be southbound only
- All existing on-street parking on the east side of the street will remain, but the direction will be reversed

Seattle Public Utilities will also construct storm sewer improvements at 3rd Ave S and S Main St as part of this project.
