I further understand that the City provides volunteer insurance for bodily injury to self and personal and property damages while I volunteer.

In addition, by signing below I verify that I have read and agree to comply with the safety guidelines of SPU’s Adopt-A-Street program as described in the Volunteer Packet, as well as public safety mandates and Governor directives concerning the COVID-19 pandemic.

- As the cleanup organizer, I acknowledge it is my responsibility ensure that all participating volunteers in my group have reviewed new safety guidelines and will sign this Safety Liability Waiver.
