- If you don't come downtown for activities, why not?
 - How could you feel welcome in this area?
 - What would need to change for you to want to come downtown?
- What ideas, big and small, do you have for how transportation and public places/parks could be better in 20 years?
(You might consider other cities, other places in the world that you love. How could we create something like that in Seattle?)
